CONGRATULATIONS!

Your pools interior has just been surfaced with a beautiful long lasting Aggregate/stone finish. ' There are a few things we'd like you to know:

- 1** We will return (usually tomorrow) to clean the surface of the Natural Rock pebbles with an acid bath. This procedure will brighten the overall appearance by exposing the pebbles and removing some of the "milky" look.
- 2** **DO NOT** enter the pool until it is completely full of water.
- 3** Keep in mind that even after this final "wash", the natural beauty of the stone will not be seen until the pool is full of water.



- 4** The finish consists of Natural Rock and cement and will vary in color, shades and consistency. This is the intended look, natural as a stream, lake or riverbed. The color and beauty will vary throughout the day as the sunlight reflects from different angles.
- 5** A Natural Rock pool will .not secrete "plaster dust' as will a tradition plaster/marcite pool. However, in areas with accumulation of debris and/or in area with pool circulation, brushing will assist in keeping the surface clean.
- 6** Proper chemical balance of your swimming pool water is very important Follow the instruction of your builder.
- 7** Natural Rock pebbles will come loose during the curing process (the first few weeks). This is to be expected. You will possibly toose 1-2 pounds of pebbles. Keep in mind your pool's interior is finished with several thousand· pounds of pebble and cement
